Consequent upon the disclosure of information with regard to admission for the Academic Session 2016-17 made by Indus International University through online, via e-samvad software /by uploading on the website of the University, it was prima facie found that the University had admitted 8 students in different courses in violation of the admission norms prescribed by the Central/ State Regulatory Bodies and the Registrar of the University was called upon to explain the position on 21.09.2016. After submission of documents, admission in respect of two students namely Shri Baljeet Singh (B. Tech Civil) and Mr. Ashraf Mohd (M. Tech ME) was regularised whereas in respect of following students, the University could not produce any satisfactory record and matter was fixed for hearing before me on 14.10.2016. However, representatives of the University appeared before me on 13.10.2016 when they were heard and following decisions were taken:
