PRELIMINARY ORDERS

Consequent upon the disclosure of information with regard to admission for the Academic Session 2016-17 made by Sri Sai University through online, via e-samvad software /by uploading on the website of the University, it was prima facie found that the University had admitted 69 students in different courses in violation of the admission norms prescribed by the Central/ State Regulatory Bodies and the Registrar of the University was called upon to explain the position on 21.09.2016. Dr. K.C. Kapoor (Dean Academics) and Mr. Surjit Kumar Dhiman (Counsellor) attended office of HP PERC. After hearing the submissions made by them and examination of documents submitted, the admission in the case of 41 students (being provisional admission on account of RLA, RLD and RLF) was regularised. The representatives of the University, in remaining violation of 28 students, could not give satisfactory reply as such the case was fixed before me on 14.10.2016 when Dr. K.K. Parmar (Dean-SW) and Dr. K.C. Kapoor (Dean Academics) appeared in person. After hearing representatives of the University and documents submitted, the following decision in 28 cases is taken as mentioned against each:

In order to sort out this issue, I have visited UGC website wherein it has been found that UGC vide its letter dated 15.09.2015 has allowed MCA programmes under Distance Education to Lovely Professional University vide its letter No. UGC/DEC/LPU/PJB/7544- 7548 dated 9.6.2014 which has been extended for the session 2015-16. The student has secured 400 marks out of 560 in BCA which is also conforming to the AICTE norms, hence the admission is ordered to be regularised.

In view of the decision rendered above, the University is directed to refund entire fee of the students whose admission has been cancelled i.e. mentioned against Sr. No. 4 to 9 and 11 to 25 immediately and complete particulars of refund i.e. name of student, amount, mode of refund, receipt of payment acknowledged by each student and copy of bank account statement (in case cheques are issued to students) be furnished to the HP PERC within 15 days from the date of decision, in default the HP PERC shall invoke relevant provisions of H.P. Private Educational Institutions (Regulatory Commission) Act, 2010 and the Rules framed thereunder. Complete information in respect of student mentioned in para-10 of the order be furnished conforming to para-24 of the Equivalence Policy of AIU within 10 days for consideration of HP PERC in default the admission shall stand cancelled. Formalities in respect of students mentioned against Sr. No.26 and

27 be completed within the stipulated period, otherwise the admission shall stand cancelled. Further orders in the matter are reserved in case information is received within the stipulated time.

Copy of the orders be supplied to the University.

Orders be hosted on the website of the Commission.

File after completion be consigned to record room. In default of compliance, the case file be put up for further orders.
