PRELIMINARY ORDERS

Consequent upon the disclosure of information with regard to admission for the Academic Session 2016-17 made by APG Shimla University through online, via e-samvad software /by uploading on the website of the University, it was prima facie found that the University had admitted 23 students in different courses in violation of the admission norms prescribed by the Central/ State Regulatory Bodies and the Registrar of the University was called upon to explain the position on 23.09.2016. Registrar of the University alongwith Dy. Registrar attended office of HP PERC and after examination of documents submitted by them, the violation increased to 77 students from 23 students. The University, however, produced record and after taking lenient view on the provisional admissions, the violations reduced in respect of 4 admissions detailed below and matter was fixed for hearing before me on 13.10.2016 when the decision against each admission was taken as follows:

In view of the decision rendered above, the University is directed to refund entire fee of the students whose admission has been cancelled i.e. mentioned against Sr. No. 2 and 3 immediately and complete particulars of refund i.e. name of student, amount, mode of refund, receipt of payment acknowledged by each student and copy of bank account statement (in case cheques are issued to students) be furnished to the HP PERC within 15 days from the date of decision, in default the HP PERC shall invoke relevant provisions of H.P. Private Educational Institutions (Regulatory Commission) Act, 2010 and the Rules framed thereunder. Complete information in respect of student mentioned at Sr. No. 1 of the order be furnished conforming to para-24 of the Equivalence Policy of AIU within 15 days for consideration of HP PERC in default the admission shall stand cancelled. Further orders in the matter are reserved in case information is received within the stipulated time.

Copy of the orders be supplied to the University.

Orders be hosted on the website of the Commission.

Case filed be submitted after expiry of period allowed for reporting compliance/ submission of documents for further/ final orders.
