Baddi University of Emerging Sciences and Technology (Establishment and
Regulation) Act and subsequent information provided by you to this deptt. vide
your letter number BUEST/Admn./2011/11952/730 dated 25-04-2011 and later
on information provided to the inspection committee.

In this matter after examining the report of the inspection
committee and information provided by you in the proforma, you are directed
to take following action in the matter:-

A) Existing Courses

1. In B.Tech.(ECE), B.Tech.(CSE), B.Tech.(IT), B.Tech.(EE),
B.Tech.(ME), B.Tech.(CE), MCA, AS&H and MBA you are allowed to
undertake admission for 2011-2012 session on the following conditions:-

- i) In these courses additional intake of students will not be more than
the norms fixed by the concerned regulatory body. If the course is
not under any regulatory body then the additional intake in it will be
equal to the intake fixed by the H.P. University for that course.
- ii) Course wise names of the existing faculty along-with their photos,
qualification and bio-data must be uploaded on your university
website within fifteen days of issue of this letter.
- iii) The new recruitment of faculty, for the proposed additional intake of
the students for the above courses, must be done, one month prior to
the start of new session. Names of all the newly recruited faculty
along-with their photos, qualifications and bio-data must be uploaded
on your university website, one month prior to start of new session.



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- iv) Names of students already admitted in the above courses should be uploaded on the university website within fifteen days of issue of this letter. Names of students who will join in the new session should be uploaded within fifteen days of the start of new session.
 - v) Necessary infrastructure, lab, library books etc. required for additional intake of students must be in place prior to start of the new session.
2. In B.Pharma, permission of Pharmacy Council of India is mandatory. You are, therefore, directed to obtain the recognition/permission of the concerned regulatory body and then only admit the students in these courses as per the norms of the concerned regulatory body. No student admissions should be made in these courses before getting the recognition/permission from the regulatory bodies.

B) New Courses

3. (a) You have proposed M. Pharma, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmaceutics, Pharmacology and Pharmacognosy. For these courses in the first instance you have to obtain the permission of Pharmacy Council of India then apply to this department.
- (b) In M.Tech.(ME) Modular, M.Tech.(CSE) Modular, M.Tech.(ECE) Modular, M.Tech.(EE) Modular, BCA, MCA-M.Tech., BBA(Hons.) in Banking, Insurance, Retail Management and Material Management, B.Com.(Hons.) in Accounting and Finance, Office Automation, MBA(Executive), BJMC, MJMC and PGD-PR&A, you are allowed to undertake admission for 2011-2012 session on the following conditions:-
- (i) In these courses new intake of students will not be more than the norms fixed by the concerned regulatory body. If the course is not under any regulatory body then the additional intake in it will be equal to the intake fixed by the H.P. University for that course.
 - (ii) The new recruitment of faculty, for the proposed new intake of the students for the above courses, must be done, one month prior to the start of new session. Names of all the newly recruited faculty along with their photos, qualifications and bio-data must be uploaded on your university website, one month prior to start of new session.
 - (iii) Names of students who will join in the new session for these courses must be uploaded within fifteen days of the start of new session.
 - (iv) Necessary infrastructure, lab, library books etc. required for starting new courses must be in place prior to start of the new session.
- (c) Admission in other new courses except the courses mentioned above is not allowed for the session 2011-2012.

You are, therefore, requested to take necessary action in the matter and action taken report may be sent to this department within a fortnight so that further action could be taken in the matter accordingly.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. BUEST/Admn/2011/12640/2302 dated, 14th July, 2011 on the subject cited above and to say that in B.Pharm and M. Pharm, you are allowed to undertake admission for 2011-2012 session on the following conditions:-

- (i) In these courses new intake of students will not be more than the norms fixed by the concerned regulatory body i.e. PCI/AICTE. In case of B.Pharm permission is given strictly as per the approval/permission given by PCI.
- (ii) The new recruitment of faculty, for the proposed new intake of the students for the above courses, must be done, one month prior to the start of new session. Names of all the newly recruited faculty along-with their photos, qualifications and bio-data must be uploaded on your university website, one month prior to start of new session.
- (iii) Names of students who will join in the new session for these courses must be uploaded within fifteen days of the start of new session.
- (iv) Necessary infrastructure, lab, library books etc. required for starting new courses must be in place prior to start of the new session.

2. Please inform that for Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmaceutics, Pharmacology and Pharmacognosy what norms are being proposed/followed by you for qualification of faculty, course content, number of students to be admitted and requirement of infrastructure etc. These norms are of which

3. Admission in other new courses except the courses mentioned above and courses allowed vide this deptt. letter of even number of dated 28th June, 2011, is not allowed for the session 2011-2012.

4. It is also directed that the conditions mentioned in this deptt. letter dated 28th June, 2011 for the existing and new courses may be complied with completely.

Subject :- **Regarding approval of Final Fee Structure in
respect of Baddi University of Emerging
Sciences and Technology for the year 2011-12.**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above
and to say that as per the provisions of Section-32 of your University
Act fee structure is required to be approved by the Government on
receipt of proposal from the University.

2. On receipt of fee structure proposal for the
academic year 2011-2012 from you, the Government on the
recommendation of the fee structure committee has approved the fee
structure of your University as per enclosed Annexure-'A' subject to
the following conditions :-

1. The Government has approved the fee for the B.Tech.
(ECE/CSE/IT/EE/ME/CE), MCA, B.Pharmacy, MBA,
M.Tech. (ME/CSE/ECE/EE) Modular, BCA, MCA-
M.Tech., BBA, MBA(Executive), M.Pharma, BJMC and
MJMC during the current session 2011-2012. The
university shall not start any course except those for which
the "course" as well as the "fees" has been approved by
the Government for the year 2011-12.
2. The university shall engage the faculty as per the norms
fixed by the regulatory bodies viz. UGC, AICTE, BCI,
MCI etc.

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3. Teaching Staff as per AICTE norms of 1:15 for proposed courses of B.Tech., BBA and MBA be provided for starting the first year classes as per revised intake of students to be submitted.
4. The university shall give the details of regular faculty in the prospectus. Further **the details of the** entire faculty including contract/part time **should be available** alongwith their photos, qualification and bio-data in the official website of the university.
5. The deficiency of the faculty shall be fulfilled atleast one month before start of the course.
6. The infrastructure viz. computers, labs and other equipments shall be provided as per norms of the regulatory bodies and shall be available before the start of course.
7. In case any deficiency is observed at later stage, suitable action as per law shall be initiated against the university.
8. The tuition fee shall be charged annually, in two equal installments.
9. The Institutional Development Charges shall be Rs.10,000/- in each case for every university, to be charged annually.
10. The Caution Money for Hostel will be Rs.5,000/- and for university it will be Rs.10,000/- in each case for every university for the whole programme/ course. This fees will be refundable in nature.
11. The university shall charge the fees under the four heads as recommended by the committee and no other fees shall be charged by the university.
12. The university shall remain free to propose the add-on charges for special facilities/activities over and above those included in the list to be provided for specific students on optional basis from time to time, but for any facility which is provided to all the students of a programme there cannot be any add on charges for that.
13. The university will clearly categorize the fees for hostellers and non-hosteller as the case may be and the details thereof as approved by the Govt. shall be given in the prospectus.
14. The university shall encourage and implement all the welfare schemes applicable for the staff as well as students.
15. In no case shall the fee fixed by the committee exceed the proposed fee structure by the university. In case, it is detected it shall be suitably reduced.

16. If the university does not have sufficient faculty and infrastructure for running a course, the university can drop the idea of starting such courses.
17. If already charging less than approved tuition fee, same shall be continued. If charging more, excess be refunded.
18. If any university charges more than the fee approved, the Govt. will take action against the university.
19. If any course/degree/programme is not recognized by the UGC for which the fee has been approved the same shall not be deemed as approved.
20. Only the courses approved by the State Government be considered as the final approval of fees.
21. The fee structure approved for the year 2010-2011 shall not be applicable for this year if the courses are not approved by the Government for continuation.
22. The University shall credit upto one percent of the total fee in the name of the H.P. Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission every year as per the direction of the Commission under the provision of Section 8(a) of the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions (Regulatory Commission) Act, 2010.
