INTERIM ORDERS

As per the fee structure determined by fee deciding Committee of Government of Himachal Pradesh different heads have been mentioned in the fee structure for various courses being run by the State Private Universities and this includes the tuition fee also within the meaning of section 5(1) (XVIII). But it has been observed that a substantial amount of this tuition fee is being utilized for various other activities and the salary liability of faculty of the Universities remains unpaid. Without qualified and satisfied faculty the academic activities and standards of education cannot be maintained in the Educational Institutions.

Therefore it is ordered that all State Private Universities should strictly abide by section 5 (1) (vi) of their Acts and while preparing the expenditure plan for the Universities they need to ensure that the tuition fee be utilized to meet out the salary expenditure of faculty on priority and the balance amount if any be spent on other academic activities.

On the issue of balance salary, the matter is listed for 22/06/2020.

Copies of order be supplied to the complainant and all the Universities for necessary compliance.
