**FINAL ORDERS**

Consequent upon the disclosure of information with regard to admission for the Academic Session 2016-17 made by Arni University through online, via e-samvad software /by uploading on the website of the University, it was prima facie found that the University had admitted 37 students in different courses in violation of the admission norms prescribed by the Central/ State Regulatory Bodies and the Registrar of the University was called upon to explain the position on 20.09.2016. Registrar of the University alongwith Kamal Singh Rana Section Officer attended office of HP PERC and after hearing them, the admission in case of one student namely Shri Randeep Singh was regularised, as he was meeting the admission norms prescribed by Government of Himachal Pradesh circulated on 13.8.2015. No satisfactory reply was given by representatives of the University and the case was fixed for hearing before me on 20.10.2016 when the decision against each admission was taken as follows:

In view of the decision rendered above, the University was directed to refund entire fee of the students whose admission has been cancelled i.e. mentioned against Sr. No. 1 to 17 immediately and complete particulars of refund i.e. name of student, amount, mode of refund, receipt of payment acknowledged by each student and copy of bank account statement (in case cheques are issued to students) were directed to be furnished to the HP PERC within 15 days from the date of decision and in default the HP PERC had clearly mentioned to invoke relevant provisions of H.P. Private Educational Institutions (Regulatory Commission) Act, 2010 and the Rules framed thereunder. Copies of detailed marks card issued by Technical Board, Jammu & Kashmir were directed to be supplied to HP PERC within 15 days from the declaration of result.

The University vide its letter dated 1.12.2016 submitted compliance report, wherein admission of S/Shri Abhishake Rana (B. Tech CS), Naresh Kumar (M. Tech. Mech), Manzoor Khan MBA, Pardeep Sharma MBA and Ms. Shamandeep Kaur MBA has been cancelled by the University. However, in the case of Shri Vyomkesh Sawhney (B.Tech. Civil) and Shri Maninder Singh (B. Tech ECE) the University has requested to relax the norms as Shri Vyomkesh Sawhney (General Category) has scored 54.40% and Shri Maninder Singh (SC Category) has secured 48% marks in the qualifying examination, whereas as per notification issued by State Government 55% marks and 50% marks are required in General and Reserved category respectively. Relaxation of 0.10% in General Category and 2% in reserved category cannot be considered by HP PERC, as other Universities shall also come forward seeking same relief, hence the request of the University is declined. Further on the basis of documents submitted by the University, admission in respect of following students is regularised:
