1	15.09.2021	<p>The Vice-Chancellor of Respondent University submitted a letter dated 13.09.2021, which is taken on record.</p> <p><b>However, following points have been heard:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Matter of Mr. Ankush Sharma who was admitted by the respondent University in M.Sc. Chemistry course during the academic session 2020-21 below the minimum eligibility criteria fixed by UGC / AICTE i.e. 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category).</li><li>2. Approval of Pharmacy Council of India for the academic session 2020-21 for running of B. Pharmacy course.</li><li>3. Degree Equivalence Certificate issued by the AIU in respect of foreign students.</li></ol> <p><b>In view of above mentioned points, the respondent University submitted as under:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. In the matter of Mr. Ankush Sharma, the Respondent University submitted a photocopy of relevant portion of Prospectus of University vide which the University has fixed eligibility criteria for M.Sc. Chemistry at their own level i.e. B.Sc. with 45% marks for General Category and 40% marks for reserved category.</li><li>2. Approval w.r.t. B. Pharmacy course for the academic session 2020-21, the University could</li></ol>	

not place the same before the Commission.

3. As far as the Degree Equivalence Certificate of all the foreign students, the Respondent University submitted that the certificates would be submitted before 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.

**In view of the above, the Commission hereby directs the Respondent University to supply the following documents on next date of hearing i.e.:**

- i) Approval of any Central / State Govt. / Regulatory Bodies to admit the student at the norms fixed by the Respondent University and against the minimum eligibility criteria fixed by UGC/AICTE.
- ii) Approval of Pharmacy Council of India for running of B. Pharmacy course for the academic session 2020-21.
- iii) Degree Equivalence Certificate as stated by Respondent University.
